Share a Recipe

Cream of Chicken Soup (Hühnerscremesuppe oder Königinsuppe)

Ingredients:

- 4 Tbsp. Butter
- 6 Tbsp Flour
- 8 Cups hot chicken broth, salt and white pepper to taste
- Pinch of nutmeg
- 2 Egg Yolks
- 1 Cup of Heavy Sweet Cream
- 1/2 Cup White Wine

Instructions:

 Melt butter in sauce pan and when hot and bubbly, stir in flour and cook until it turns bright golden.

- 2. Gradually add hot chicken broth, stirring constantly so mixture stays smooth. Season to taste with salt, pepper and nutmeg.
- 3. Beat egg yolks into cream and add a little hot thickened chicken stock.
- 4. Mix together and pour egg cream mixture into remaining thickened stock that is very hot, but has been removed from flame/heat. This mixture can be reheated over a low flame briefly, but be sure soup does not come to a boiling point, as egg will curdle.
- Check seasoning and add white wine slowly to taste.

If you prefer a slightly thicker soup, use 1 additional tablespoon of four and one more egg yolk.
